# PowerMyLearning's Evidence Base



## Math Academic Achievement

- +8pp increase in K-2 students' math scores
- +28% improvement and statistically significant difference in proportion of students exceeding or meeting grade-level math benchmarks ( $p < .001$ )



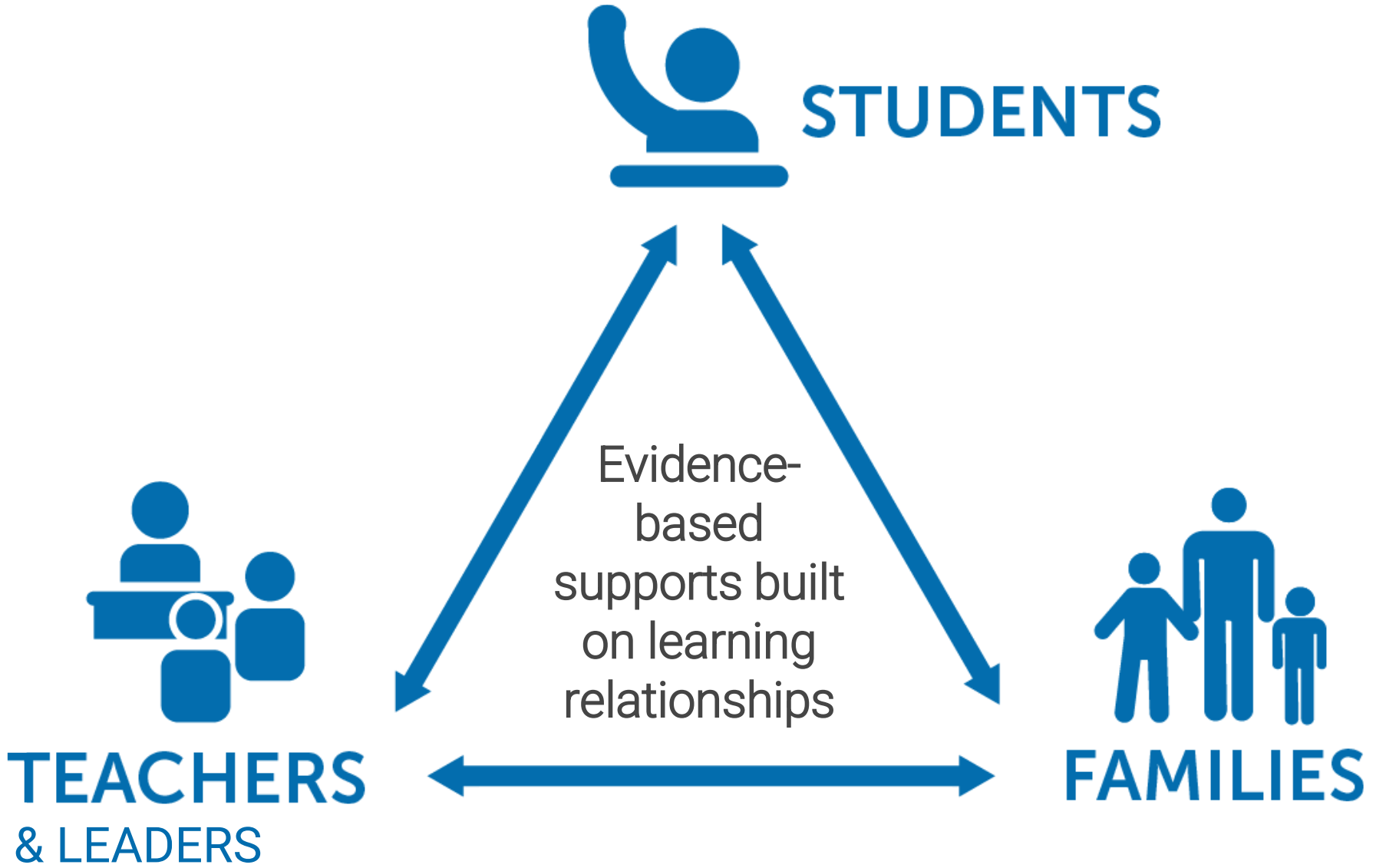
## Social Emotional Learning (SEL)

- Statistically significant improvement in overall student SEL (+7pp,  $p = .02$ )
- More pronounced SEL impact on high needs students, including Black and Hispanic students, Multilingual Learners (MLLs), and students with learning differences



## Teacher Practice

- Statistically significant improvement across core areas of instructional practice including instructional planning and design, student agency, data-driven instruction, and learning environment.
- Significant improvement on SEL-aligned instructional practices: inclusive community (+53pp,  $p < .001$ ), culture of learning (+50pp,  $p < .002$ ), and SEL classroom routines (+26pp,  $p = .002$ )
- +8pp increase in teacher retention

# Coaching for Teachers for K-12

BSAP Vendor

Support teachers in building high-quality instruction through:

- **Curriculum Knowledge:** Understand how the curriculum sequences content and how to best connect and situate that content to teach within learning progressions
- **Pedagogical Knowledge:** Understanding what teaching approaches best fit the content and how to support development of positive mindsets and habits of mind
- **Focus on four key instructional domains:** Learning Environment Instructional, Planning and Delivery, Data Driven Decision Making, and Student Agency

Delivery:

- ✓ In-person, up to 6 hours/day, up to 4 teachers/day on a school campus
- ✓ 1 coach per teacher
- ✓ Can provide coaching for Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies
- ✓ 10 days minimum recommended
